The Department of Local Government Punjab has notified Rules on 12.02.2015 under Section 36 of the Act.

The street vendors' survey is being conducted in 165 ULBs of Punjab, out of which 85 ULBs have completed the Street Vending Survey and identified 11952 Nos of Street Vendors in their respective towns.

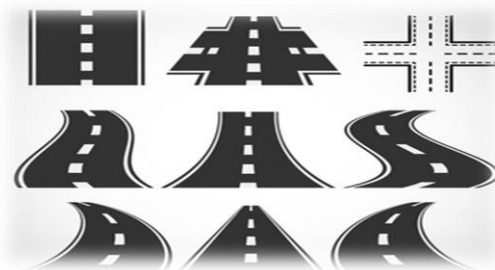

Roads, Buildings, Sewerage & Water Supply

- The Government of Punjab has taken steps to clean the Budha Nallah and has appointed M/s Engineers India Limited for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for the Rejuvenation and Development of Budha Nallah. The inception report has been submitted by the Consultant to Government of Punjab.
- The major roads of the city of Ludhiana would now be cleaned mechanically. MCL has invited tenders for outsourcing the cleaning of roads with mechanical sweepers.
- Out of 3632 Dwelling Units being constructed under BSUP Scheme, 2176 nos. DUs have been completed with all the infrastructures. 1400 nos. DUs have been allotted to the beneficiaries out of which 418 nos. beneficiaries have been shifted.
- The work on the construction of 2nd phase of Indoor Stadium on Pakhowal Road is going on in full swing and is likely to be completed by December 2015. With the completion of Phase-II, the stadium will become functional.





MC to set up debris plant

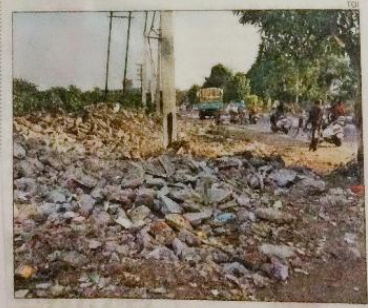

Ludhiana: Moving forward with the plan to establish Construction and Demolition (C&D) plant and for bringing relief to residents regarding the construction waste dumped in open or at their vacant plots, municipal corporation (MC) has earmarked two spots — Noorpur bet and Jainpur near Harbawal, and the plant will be established at one of the spots. With the capacity of 100 metric tons/day, the project will be taken up under the smart city project. Residents may also be able to sell the waste to the company taking up the project as the company will be selling the end products which will be made out of waste. However, officials said that this is the policy matter which will be framed while giving the contract. Also, residents are only liable to dispose of the waste by themselves.

Residents have been complaining for a long time against dumping of construction waste/rubble in the open and also in green belts especially in Model Town and S B S Nagar area, which is also becoming an eyesore. Even MC authorities in the past have claimed that they have no place to dump the construction waste, which is the reason that it is dumped in the open at different places. The plant will also provide relief to residents since they will be able to dispose of waste at a designated area. One of the residents of Model town B block area,INDERJEET SINGH, said that dumping of rubble, construction waste has created much nuisance in the past. He said that the area is one of the posh areas of the city and even then, road at back of the area was filled with rubble and construction debris.

After residents complained about the same, authorities organized a cleanliness drive in the area but even then, waste continued to get accumulated.

Another resident Harsimran Singh said that such plants should be established in different parts of the city to facilitate residents better. Officials however said that dumping sites will be established at different points of the city Superintending Engineer (SE) of MC Pawan Sharma said that firstly they decided to establish the plant at Noorpur bet but then they considered Jainpur dump site which is relatively closer and residents would not face trouble dumping the waste here. "It is yet to be decided whether residents will be paid for dumping waste," Sharma said that they are working on the project and the consultancy firm appointed under smart city project has been asked to come up with detailed project report (DPR) regarding the same. He said that tenders will be floated after results of the assembly elections.

City to get 5 parks worth ₹5.5 cr in 5 yrs

Design In Line With Amrut Scheme Guidelines

Ludhiana: The MC horticulture department is keen to turn green belts and parks in the city. Punjab Municipal Corporation (PMMC) under the Amrut Mission for Urban Transformation and Urban Development (AMUT) project of the Government of India, sanctioned ₹5.5 crore for development of five parks in Ludhiana.

The design has been proposed keeping in mind the Amrut scheme guidelines. Amrut scheme guidelines, approved by the Government of India, envisaged into plan areas, community recreation, recreational activity and aesthetic.

Two parks are to be developed initially. These include Rose garden, which will cover an area of 12.49 lakh sq ft, and Lathi Park, which will cover an area of 12.49 lakh sq ft. The parks will have landscaped areas for social interaction, parking facilities, and drinking facilities with improved landscaping. The parks will have facilities for children, benches and play equipment.

There will be play squares integrated with fountains, sculptures of children, drawing wall for children, illumination and garden clocks.
